15. Förkunskapskrav och andra villkor för tillträde till kursen	Enrollment to the master's programme in ICT for development and successful completion of the course 'Understanding ICT for development I'.
16. Kursens uppläggning och innehåll	<p>The course will provide a broad perspective to ICT4D as a phenomenon and how this can be and has been applied specifically and in practice through a number of cases. During the course, students will critically analyse and discuss both on-going and finalised ICT4D projects with the aim of building their understanding of the conditions and challenges of these projects from the theoretical and practical perspectives to development.</p> <p>The course applies so-called case methodology where students will be presented with a number of cases that introduce a dilemma typical to the ICT for development projects. Students are required to analyse each case and through own critical work and discussion with peers come up with a solution or several solutions to the dilemma.</p>

Kursens mål	<p>After finishing the course students are expected to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - - demonstrate ability to critically and on the basis of development theories examine development projects - demonstrate insight of the roles of ICT and knowledge in development collaboration - demonstrate insight of the scientific possibilities and challenges related to practical development projects
18. Undervisning	Course is run online and teaching is provided if resources allow this. Decisions regarding course structure and obligatory sections are taken by the course leader which is appointed by the head of

	the department.
19. Kunskapskontroll och examination	<p>a. Decisions regarding examination are taken by the course leader appointed by the head of the department.</p> <p>b. Assessment is done according to the seven-point grading scale : A = Excellent B = Very good C = Good D = Satisfactory E = Sufficient Fx = Insufficient F = Completely Insufficient</p> <p>c. Grading criteria of the course is announced in the beginning of the course.</p> <p>The course is examined continuously. Total amount of credits: 7,5.</p> <p>d. To receive a final grade for the whole course, grade Passed is required for all the modules.</p> <p>e. In addition, the student who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- gets grade E on the final exam will be given an opportunity to do a supplement. This means that the student through this supplement may receive grade E, not higher, on the actual exam. Examiner will inform the students who are eligible to do a supplement when the results for the exam are published. Supplement must be submitted in due time and can only be used for raising the grade in the present exam.- has received at least grade E cannot raise the grade by a new exam- has taken the same exam twice with the same examiner without passing has a right to a new examiner, provided that no special reasons against this exist.
